Pursuant to the Order dated 11.05.2012 of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court passed in W.P. (C) No. 8889 of 2011, on its Own Motion-Vs- Department of Women and Child Development & Others and as per suggestions made accordingly by the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights vide their letter No.32-3/12-NCPCR(PD) Vol.V(20) a panel of experts comprising the following eminent lawyers, social activists and a representative of Women & Child Development Department and headed by District Legal Services Authority or its representative is hereby constituted for each District of the State to inspect concerned District Jails/Central Jails once in a month and submit their reports and recommendations to the State Legal Services Authority with regard to juveniles languishing in the Jails contrary to the proviso JJ Act due to wrong recording of their age at the time of investigation.

The expenditure of the panel constituted for the purpose shall be borne by the concerned District Administration.




