Sub: Enhancement of limits of expenditure towards Imprest Money (One time Permanent Advance)


Proposal for enhancement of limits of Imprest Money(One Time Permanent Advance) for Police Stations in the State was under active consideration of the Government for quite some time. In partial modification of this Department letter no 53193 date 20-12-2006, Government has been pleased to enhance the ceiling of Imprest Money (One time Permanent Advance) from Rs 4000/- and Rs 6,000/- for Rural and Urban Police Stations to Rs. 10,000/- for each such Police Station in the State.

This shall come into force from the first day of the next month of issuance of this Order. This charge is debitible from the head as indicated separately for the District Police and Commissionerate.


