ORDER

No.HOME-DA1-RULE-0007-2018/34881 Dated, Bhubaneswar, the 13.08, 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Police Act, 1861 (Act 5 of 1861) the State Government do hereby make the following orders further to amend the Odisha Police Signals Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Constables, Communication) Order, 2016, namely: -

1. (1) This Order may be called the Odisha Police Signals Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Constables, Communication) Amendment Order, 2018.
(2) This Order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Odisha Gazette.
2. In the Odisha Police Signals Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Constables, Communication) Order, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as said Order), in order 2 in clause (b) for the word, hyphen and figure, "Order-7" the word and figure "Order 6" shall be substituted.
3. In the said Order in order 5, in the first proviso to clause (e) for the word, hyphen and figure, "Order-8", the word and figure "Order 7" shall be substituted.
4. In the said Order, in Order 6 for sub order (2), the following sub order shall be substituted, namely:-

"(2) Recruitment Centers- Physical efficiency test (PET) and Written test of the recruitment shall be conducted at Koraput, Sambalpur and Cuttack. There shall be constituted a "Zonal Selection Board" at Koraput and Sambalpur with the following members who shall conduct the Physical Efficiency Test at locations other than Cuttack as per the direction of the "Selection Board" constituted under sub order (1) of order 6.

a) Inspector General/ Deputy Inspector General of Police (to be nominated by the Director General of Police)- **Chairman.**

(b) Superintendent of Police /Commandant (to be nominated by the Director General of Police)- **Member.**

(c) One Deputy Superintendent of Police (to be nominated by the Director General of Police) - **Member.**

(d) One representative of the Central Para-military Force not below the rank of Commandant(to be nominated by Government of India Ministry of Home Affairs) only for India Reserve Battalion -Member.

(e) District Welfare Officer/ his representative as special invitee

(f) Chief District Medical Officer / his representative as special invitee

(3) The Physical Efficiency Test at Cuttack shall be conducted by the "Selection Board".

(4) At the time of submission of application the applicant shall indicate the place at which he desires to attend Physical Efficiency Test and Written Test. The candidates will have to appear the written test at the place where he appears the Physical Efficiency Test."

5. In the said order in order 9 for clause (a) of sub order (3) the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-

" (a) Written test shall consist of objective type multiple choice questions in Odia language, English Language, Arithmetic, Computer Awareness, General knowledge, Aptitude and Logical reasoning etc. The standard of the questions shall be such that a student who has passed + 2 Examinations with Diploma in Computer Application (DCA) will be able to answer. Different sets of Question papers may be prepared, each having the same questions which will be differently serial numbered."

6. In the said order, in order 9, for sub order (4) the following sub order shall be substituted, namely:-

"(4) Physical Efficiency Test (PET): Allotted marks-35:

(i) For Men (all categories)

The Physical Efficiency Test shall comprise of the following events with marks indicated against each:-

(a) Run-1.6 Kms if covered within 5minutes	:	10 Marks
5 minutes 30 Seconds	:	07 Marks
6 minutes	:	04 Marks
Beyond 6 minutes	:	Disqualified
(b) High Jump Qualifying height-1.22 Meters (3 chances)		
If cleared in 3 chances	:	5 Marks
Not able to clear	:	Disqualified

Note: Only those who qualify high jump of 1.22 Meters shall be allowed to compete to jump 1.38 Meters in single chance. Only those candidates, who qualify 1.38 Meters, shall be given to compete for 1.50 Meters in single chance.

Higher marks shall be awarded as follows:

If cleared 1.38 Meters	:	7 Marks
If cleared 1.50 Meters	:	10 Marks

Note: Marks shall be awarded only for the highest jump cleared.

(c) Cross-Country: (5KM), Allotted Marks: 15

If covered within	20 Minutes	:	15 Marks
	23 Minutes	:	10 Marks
	25 Minutes	:	05 Marks
Beyond 25 Minutes	:		Disqualified

(d) Swimming (40 Meters): (Only to qualify)

If covered within 08 Minutes	:	Qualified
Beyond 08 Minutes	:	Disqualified"

(ii) For Women (all categories) Allotted Marks-35

The Physical Efficiency Test shall comprise of the following events with marks indicated against each:-

(a) Run: If a distance of 1.6 Km is covered within	7.15 Minutes:	20 Marks
	7.45 Minutes:	15 Marks
	8.15 Minutes:	10 Marks
	8.30 Minutes:	05 Marks
	Beyond 8.30 Minutes:	Disqualified

(b) Broad Jump: Qualifying Length 2.75 Meters.

Marks shall be given for the best 3 chances.

If cleared	3.25 Meters	:	15 Marks
	3.00 Meters	:	10 Marks
	2.75 Meters	:	05 Marks
If not cleared	2.75 Meters	:	Disqualified

(c) Swimming: (40 Meters): Only to Qualify

If covered within 10 Minutes	:	Qualified
Beyond 10 Minutes	:	Disqualified

Note: If a candidate fails to qualify in any of the above events, he/she shall be disqualified and shall not be allowed to participate in the subsequent test or recruitment process."




