Sub:-Declaration of Holidays on the
Demise of State Leaders.

The Government of India have taken a decision in their
Office memorandum No.3/2/97-Public dt.21.12.97 of Ministry of Home
Affairs regarding discontinuance of practice of declaring a holiday
on the demise of National leaders except in case of death of the
President or Prime Minister in harness.

The Government of Orissa after careful consideration
on the issue have decided for discontinuance of the practice of
declaring a holiday on the demise of State Leaders except in case of
death of the Governor or Chief Minister in harness. As such no holiday
may be declared in future on the demise of any State leader except
in case of death of the Governor or Chief Minister in harness.

This supersedes all previous instructions on the subject.
